## **Details**

This competition will be held under the rules and regulations of FARS (Permit applied for).

All skaters must agree to drug testing if requested by FARS.

Clubs must ensure that all skaters under the age of 18 have CPU forms and the club secretary must sign the declaration at the bottom of each entry form.

All skating ages are as at 1<sup>st</sup> January 2010.

In dance events, ladies steps are to be skated unless otherwise indicated. (see Fun Team)

Closing date for entries is 8<sup>th</sup> May 2010. No late entries will be accepted. No refunds will be made after this date.

Kent Club reserves the right to refuse any application and/or limit entries to events.

All events will be further split by age and/or standard and some events may be run on a knock-out basis. However, no adult events will be run on a knock-out basis.

Kent Club reserves the right to cancel any competition with only two skaters.

Where skaters are skating up a standard (where permitted), please indicate with \* on entry sheets. Please also ensure where applicable, that FARS registration dates are completed.

It is anticipated that all freeskating events will take place on Saturday (together with some of the dance events)

Standard for all events is as at the day of competition.

Club uniform should be worn for Team events.

Music should be supplied on tape or CD with the skaters name and club clearly shown.

# Event Schedule 2010

## **FREE SKATING EVENTS**

### **Event 1 – Elements Non Medallist Skaters – 13 years and under**

**Skaters entering Event 1 may also enter Event 2 but cannot enter any other freeskating events.**

**This is for NOVICE skaters who are entering their FIRST OPEN event and who are 13 years and under.**

**Elements to be skated in the order below within 65 seconds. Background music will be provided :**

Arabesque  
Two foot jump from forwards to backwards and to forwards again  
1 or 2 foot spin (entry optional)  
A Three Jump  
A Spread  
A Toe Loop

### **Event 2 – Non Medallists Free Skating**

**For Non Medallist Freeskaters entering their FIRST OPEN event**

**Skaters entering Event 2 may also enter Event 1 but cannot enter any other freeskating events.**

2 minute programme (only single jumps allowed)

### **Event 3 - Non Medallists Free Skating**

**For Non Medallists Freeskaters NOT entering their First open Event**

2 minute programme

### **Event 4 – Elementary and Preliminary Free Skating**

**Skaters entering Event 4 may also enter Event 5**

2 minute programme

## **Event 5 – Preliminary Free Skating**

**Skaters entering Event 5 may also enter Event 4**

3 minute programme

## **OSP EVENTS**

### **Event 6 – OSP – Any Standard, any age**

**Normal OSP rules will apply – 2 full sequences  
This event will be split by age and/or standard**

## **DUO EVENTS**

**Please note that skaters may only enter 1 duo event  
Skating up is allowed, but please indicate on your entry forms**

### **Event 7 – Non Medallist Duos**

**Maximum entry – 3 duos per club**

**Dances :** Canasta Tango  
City Blues

### **Event 8 – Elementary and Preliminary Duos**

**Maximum entry – 3 duos per club**

**Dances :** Canasta Tango  
City Blues

### **Event 9 – Up to Bronze Duos**

**Maximum entry – 3 duos per club**

## **Event 10 – Inter Silver and above Duos**

**Maximum entry – 3 duos per club**

## **SOLO DANCE EVENTS**

**Skaters may enter 1 solo dance event and 1 open standard dance event only**

**For Novice skaters registered on or after 1<sup>st</sup> January 2010**

**Dances :** Edges and Arabesque to Tango 100

**For Novice skaters registered from June 2009**

**Dances :** City Blues

### **Event 13 – Non Medallist and Elementary Solo Dance**

### **Event 21 – Solo Dance Team Non Medallists up to 16 years**

**Maximum entry - 3 teams per club**
